

This is specifically for you if you identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander or have children that identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.

Circle of Security is an internationally acclaimed parenting program, based on decades of research about how secure parent-child relationships can be supported and strengthened.

The program will help you:

- Strengthen attachment security between parent and child
- Understand your child's emotional world by learning to read emotional needs
- Respond rather than react to behaviours in order to support emotional regulation
- Support your child's ability to successfully manage emotions
- Build effective relationship skills to enhance your child's security and self-esteem
